3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Tips for man and environment

Toxic if swallowed. Irritating to eyes. May cause sensitization by contact with skin. Very toxic to aquatic organisms

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation

If inhaled, remove patient from contaminated atmosphere without exposing themselves same. If the patient has trouble breathing give oxygen.

Skin Contact

Remove contaminated clothing immediately. Rinse with soap and water. If symptoms persist, consult a physician.

Eye Contact

Rinse thoroughly with water for at least 15 minutes and consult a doctor. **Ingestion**

Rinse mouth with water. Induce vomiting if the patient is fully conscious, the time since ingestion is less than 30 minutes and no one is available to help medical (vomiting should not enter the airway). Keep your body at rest protect from heat loss. Call a doctor immediately and show the road security.

Physician information

Symptoms

Symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition (gastrointestinal disturbances, dyspnea, narrowing of the airways, bradycardia, miosis, spasm, chronic). Ingestion may cause gastrointestinal irritation, nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.

Risk

NOT to be confused with organophosphorus compounds! This product contains a Carbamate cholinesterase inhibitor.

Treatment

Monitoring respiratory and cardiac functions. Constant monitoring of blood counts and cholinesterase activity. It must perform end tracheal intubation and gastric lavage, followed by administration of charcoal. Artificial respiration and / or oxygen may be necessary. Elimination by dialysis (forced alkaline diuresis).

Against convulsions: Give diazepam: for adults 5-10 mg intravenously if necessary until fully sedated; for children 2.5 mg intravenously.

Treatment: High dose of atropine (1 to 4 mg for adults) repeatedly until the necessary. Recovery: spontaneous.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing media: Dry chemical, carbon dioxide, halon, water spray or standard foam.

Unsuitable extinguishing: High pressure water jet media

Special exposure hazards: Do not release chemically contaminated water into drains, soil and surface waters. **Special protective**: As for all fires involving chemicals: chemical protection suit, suitable gloves equipment for fire-fighters and boots, and self-contained breathing apparatus.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal precautions: Use personal protective equipment.

Methods for cleaning up: Do not touch spilled material. Stop leak if you can do it without risk. For small spills, take up with sand or other absorbent material and place into containers for later disposal. Move containers from spill area. For larger spills, dike far ahead of spill for later disposal. Keep unnecessary people away. Isolate hazard area and deny entry. Ventilate closed space.

Environmental precautions: Prevent contamination of water.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling precautions Keep product in original tightly closed container; avoid exposure by inhalation; do not get on skin, eyes or clothing; do not eat, drink or smoke when handling; wash hands before eating, drinking or smoking.

Storage Store in locked, well-ventilated storeroom, away from children and unauthorized personnel, and food and animal feed.
